Challenging current models of delivery, he will advocate the use of radical institutions to deliver superior performance for the benefit of society.

1_ The Worshipful Company of Educators

The Worshipful Company of Educators was the 109th Livery Company to be granted this status by the City of London, in 2013. It was founded as a Guild in 2001 within the philanthropic tradition of the City of London livery companies. It provides a forum through meetings and social occasions to bring together members from all parts of the education world to discuss and exchange views on matters of topical interest. The Educators' Trust Fund - Charity Reg. No. 1104355 - provides Annual Awards and Bursaries to celebrate outstanding, innovative and inspirational practice in a variety of educational and community settings.

2_ The Franklin Lecture

The Company of Educator's Franklin Lecture is named after the late Professor Dr Raoul N Franklin CBE FEng, Foundation Master of the Guild of Educators, the precursor of the current Worshipful Company. The first Franklin Lecture was delivered in 2001. In 2021 the lecture was given virtually by Sir David Cannadine due to the Covid Pandemic.

3_ Master Educator Caroline Haines

Caroline Haines CC, has been an elected member of the Court of Common Council of the City of London Corporation for the Ward of Queenhithe since 2017.
